Do we *dare* to say 'Our Father'?

The Lord's Prayer at Mass is introduced by the words, 'At the Saviour's command, and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say "Our Father ..."

Why is it daring to say 'Our Father'?

We might remember the ways in which the people of the Old Testament were afraid to look at the Lord. But as Christians, it is not because we are afraid of God that it is daring to call God 'Father'.

It is daring to believe that we should be so intimate with the Father of Jesus Christ as to call him Father, as Jesus did. We are not being too presumptuous to call ourselves God's children. That is what we are. We are adopted children, where Jesus is his begotten Son. But we are reborn as his children, as the Rite of Baptism proclaims.

Next time we say 'Our Father', we could remember that it is a tremendous privilege to do so.

In today's Gospel reading, the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray, so He taught them the "Our Father."

In the first part of the "Our Father" we give glory to God by praising Him, and in the second part we ask Him for the things we need. Asking for our daily bread can be asking both for the things like food that our bodies need, and for the spiritual things as well, especially Holy Communion. Next we ask for forgiveness for our sins and for God to keep us away from temptation and evil.

Jesus said that if a father on earth would give his children the things they need, then God, who is our Father in Heaven, will certainly give us what we need. All He wants us to do is show that we trust in Him by asking Him.

Make sure you say the "Our Father" every day to praise God our Father and ask Him for everything you need.

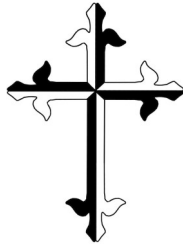
