## What do we treasure?

The Gospel parable heard today reminds us that we often value too highly the things which are going to pass away.

The symbolic words, actions and material objects used in our religion are all aimed at helping us recognize this. They point to the transcendent, the other-worldly realities. They are not supposed to be ends in themselves. Sometimes this gets lost in the admiration of the beauty or preciousness of the objects, the strangeness of the language, the artificial nature of the gestures or movements. We have to take care in understanding their meaning.

It is especially important to understand the person of the ordained minister. The 'priest' is only a priest because he represents the only priest, Jesus Christ. What is more, all Christians represent Christ the priest in various ways. In some ways, all our actions are to be actions of Christ the priest. That is what makes our actions, words and decisions holy, when we do them in the name of Christ. Following are a couple of examples of actions we might take.

Bishop Gregory O'Kelly has written about the review of abortion law and medical practice under way in South Australia. A report is due to be published this month. Bishop O'Kelly asks, and I agree, that this is a good time for parishioners to express their views to their MPs. We will also add prayers to the Prayers of the Faithful at Masses, and remember to offer prayers and support to women 'grappling with an unplanned pregnancy and those who are experiencing grief and loss.'

### Jesus teaches us not to be Greedy

In today's Gospel reading, a man tells Jesus that his brother is being unfair to him. But Jesus knows that the man is just being greedy, so He tells him the parable of the rich farmer. One year he had such a good harvest that he couldn't fit it all into his barns. He tore down his old barns and built new ones, so that he could store his food for many years. But just when he thought he would be able to rest and enjoy his food, he died.

This story is a warning against being greedy. Jesus is not saying that we should not save food or that we shouldn't save or money. He just wants us to use the things we have wisely, but not be too attached to them.

Think of something that is really special to you. How would you feel if you lost it or it was taken away? Do your feelings show that you care too much about things? Try to think of your belongings in such a way that if you lost them you wouldn't be too upset. Remember as a child of God, you already have everything you need! Let's focus on knowing God and doing what He wants us to do.
