Congratulations to more girls and boys of our parish who have now completed their Christian initiation this weekend. Thanks are due to the teachers from the three schools, Rosary, Blackfriars and St Dominic's. Without their teaching and organizing this event could not have taken place, it's as simple as that. They gave generously of their time, over and above what they were expected to do. We all owe them many thanks.

The Liturgy of the Word this weekend encourages us to practice humility. How do we manage that? We all know to *act* humble, but how humble are we inside? Humility actually comes from strength, the knowledge of our Christian dignity, which cannot be taken away from us. Then we don't have to stand on our status or reputation.

There is a pride which is not incompatible with humility. It comes from knowing that we are God's creatures, subject then to God in all things. From that we can understand that we were made by God because God wanted us to be, God wanted us to know him, and know the secrets of the universe – still gradually being uncovered – and through that to know him. We have been made able to know ourselves too, and the working of our complex human nature – also still gradually being uncovered! – and again knowing God through our knowledge of ourselves. It is for the sake of this discovery that God has shown us so much about ourselves by giving us his law and above all by giving us his son.

Being subject to God is not humiliation but glorious.

It's Fathers' Day! Let all fathers today know their God-given dignity as fathers, and be glad to take up the valuable role of fatherhood. May God bless you all in the love of your families and the love of God.

We pray for many things for ourselves or for others. Don't forget to pray for a new bishop for the Archdiocese of Adelaide.

Each year, the Catholic Church in Australia dedicates one Sunday to Child Protection. This year it is next Sunday, 8 September. As the Child Protection Unit of Adelaide says, 'it is a reminder to us all to play our part and respond to the voices of children.'
