Compassion

In the issue of Cathnews for 18 September, there are two stories side by side.

One is headlined 'Compassion is the language of God'. It reports a homily of Pope Francis. He refers to Jesus who brought back to life the only son of the widow of Naim, because of his compassion for her. *"Compassion allows you to see reality; compassion is like the lens of the heart: it allows us to take in and understand the true dimensions. In the Gospels, Jesus is often moved by compassion. And compassion is also the language of God,"* and *"Our God is a God of compassion, and compassion - we can say - is the weakness of God, but also His strength,"* he said.

The other story is headlined, 'Cardinal Pell lodges High Court appeal'. We don't know yet whether the High Court will agree to hear the appeal. The court has to decide what the evidence before them indicates. But there is more to reality than that. The court is not concerned with compassion.

The compassion that is the language of God, as Pope Francis teaches, is due to everyone. We well understand the compassion that is due to the victims of crimes such as the cardinal is accused of. As well, compassion is due to their families and friends who also have to deal with the effects of the abuse on their loved ones. These crimes were committed by people who were bearing the name of Christ but who betrayed that name, as they betrayed the trust that protected them. Ashamed as I am, there were Dominican men amongst them.

We had better acknowledge that compassion is also due to Cardinal Pell, and all those who have been accused, whether innocent or guilty. There is also to be compassion—which implies understanding the feelings of another and responding accordingly—for the people who now view the Church and all its workers with suspicion. That is why you and I are being made to go through the tiresome routine of police checks. These do not benefit the victims of abuse, nor guarantee that such crimes will not occur again.

The compassion of God towards them must be shown by the church in other ways: support in counselling, and compensation, recognition of the reality—another facet of compassion as Pope Francis explains. The often-repeated apologies and admissions by bishops and others must be backed up by a change in the attitude of church ministers. We cannot accept a position of privilege again.

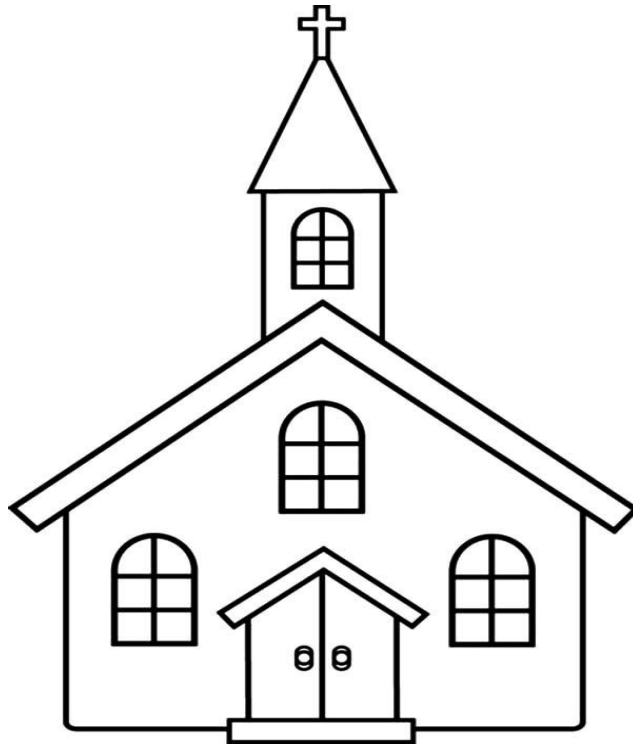
