## SOCIAL JUSTICE SUNDAY – MAKING IT REAL



(The first person who will tell me correctly what is strange about this picture will get a special prize!)

On one Sunday in the year the Bishops ask us to consider their social justice statement, to take a "Ten Steps" brochure and a prayer card. (This year the prayer card is Pope Francis' variation on the Prayer of St Francis.)

The topics are often uncomfortable reading. The bishops often challenge us to review our lifestyle and make painful changes.

This year it is different. The bishops have chosen to reflect on a question vital to any Christian raising a young family. They invite us to 'reflect on how the internet has changed the way we communicate, work, learn and do business - and how we can contribute towards a more just and loving digital world. We are called to "make real" the love of God in the lives of our neighbours - both off-line and on.' (Bishop Terence Brady, auxiliary bishop of Sydney) They situate the discussion within the framework of Christian faith.

This statement reminded me that living our Christian faith involves us in social justice all the time. It may not always be a matter of global problems. We may not always be asked to make a difference to the lives of peoples in far distant countries. But in every decision as Christians we are to act with justice, God's justice.

Everything that we have, all that we are, comes from God. All that happens to us is a gift from God. Well, bad things do not come from God. But the endurance to face them comes from God. The hope that all things will turn out for our good comes from our faith that God is good.

Our feet, our hands, our eyes and ears and all our senses and activities are part of God's plan for the world through us. Let us put them deliberately at God's disposal.

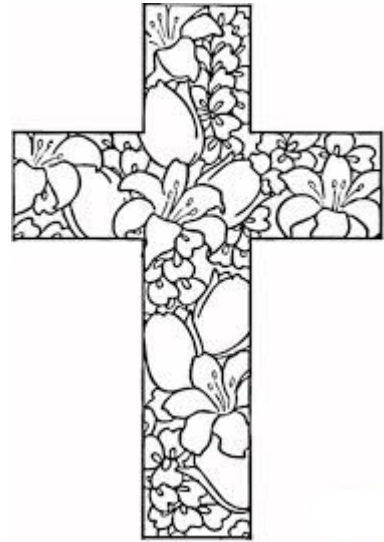
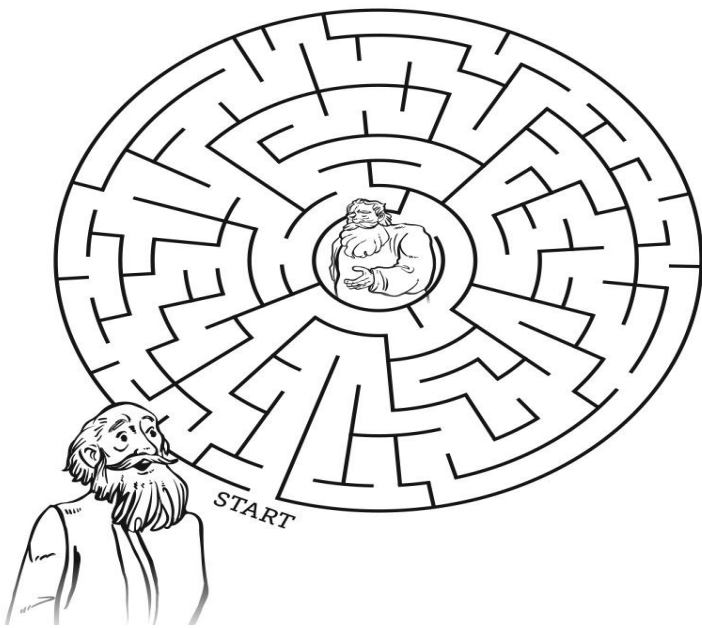

# THE RICH MAN & LAZARUS

Guide Lazarus to Abraham



## Lazarus and the Rich Man

Did you know that God sometimes sounds a "wake up" alarm in our lives? He speaks to our heart and says, "It is time to wake up and follow me." Some people hit the snooze button and say, "Not now Lord, call me again -- a little bit later." Some people hit that "snooze button" so many times that they get to where they don't even hear God's voice. When they finally wake up, they find out that it is too late. That is what happened in our Bible story today.

In today's Gospel Jesus tells the story of a rich man who wore the finest clothes and lived in luxury. A poor man named Lazarus sat outside the rich man's gate. Not only was he poor, he was sick and his body was covered with sores. He hoped the rich man might have pity on him- Lazarus would have been happy with even the scraps leftover from the rich man's table. But every day, the rich man passed by Lazarus without even giving him a thought. He passed by Lazarus so many times he got to the point he didn't even see him at all.

Once the men died everything change. The rich man wasn't able to go to Heaven. He got what he deserved for thinking only of himself while he was alive. Lazarus, on the other hand, went to be with Abraham in Heaven. He had suffered so much while he was alive, but now he was perfectly happy.

The rich man learned his lesson and wanted to go back to earth to warn his brothers. But of course, this wasn't possible.

What does this story make you want to do for the poor and suffering people around you? Let us pray that we listen to God's voice before it's too late.

*Dear Father, when you sound the alarm telling us it is time to wake up and follow you, may we never be guilty of hitting the snooze alarm saying, "Later, Lord." Instead, let us rise up and follow you. Amen.*
