A Great New Saint

Saint John Henry Newman is perhaps best known for the hymns 'Lead Kindly Light', and 'Firmly I believe and truly', or for 'The Dream of Gerontius'.

As an Anglican he worked for the renewal of the Anglican church, until his rigorous scholarship led him to believe that the Catholic church was the true church.

As a Catholic theologian he is sometimes called 'the father of the Second Vatican Council'. This is not only because his ideas are reflected in the work of this council. It is also because his thinking helps to correct some of the misinterpretations of the council. (Ian Ker, biographer of Newman.)

Ker also wrote: 'The reservation of the Blessed Sacrament in Catholic churches impressed and moved Newman more than anything else'. As well, Newman, when he learned what Catholics believed about the Mass, knew that each celebration was the most important event in the world.



Prince Charles wrote a tribute of Newman for the occasion of his canonization. "In the age when he lived, Newman stood for the life of the spirit against the forces that would debase human dignity and human destiny. In the age in which he attains sainthood, his example is needed more than ever – for the manner in which, at his best, he could advocate without accusation, could disagree without disrespect and, perhaps most of all, could see differences as places of encounter rather than exclusion."

On another matter: each week at Sunday Mass, we pray the 'Prayers of the Faithful'. But they are usually taken out of books. They are not your prayers, and often too wordy. So, what if you wrote these prayers? Let me know. You would not need to write more than once a month. If you can write a sentence in English, and know something about the parish and our people, you are suitable. Best of all, you don't need a police clearance for this!

This weekend we are reminded to pray constantly, and to pray for justice. This means God's justice above all, the victory of Jesus. God's justice is made real in the world when Christians live the commandment of love, even for those who are against us.

Next weekend we will be asked to support Catholic Mission. Missions need support because the local people do not have the financial resources to support clergy and religious. There will be special envelopes, so no need of a third collection.

Thanks to all who took part in the Rosary last Sunday. The reflections were from a little booklet called, 'The Rosary with Pope Francis.' They are extracts from various talks or homilies of Pope Francis.

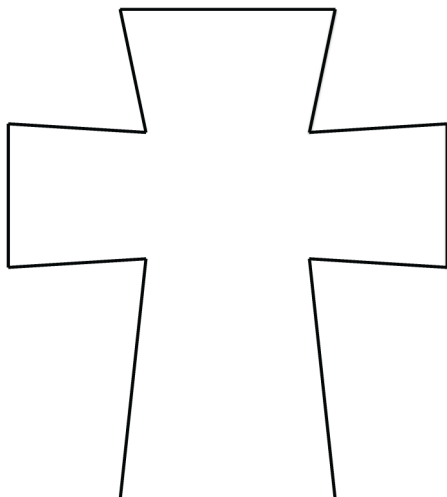
God is not like that dishonest judge. God hears and answers our prayers because he loves us. But does God always do what we ask when we ask Him to?

CHANGES TO THE POLICE CHECK SCREENING PROCESS

September 1st 2019

All volunteers **aged 14 years and over** are required to have a Police Check. Persons aged **over 80 years are no longer exempted**. If these changes apply to you, please fill in an application form (available in the Sacristy) and then get Fr Paul, Mary Mathew or Siobhan Rowe to do your 100pt ID check. Your applications will then be forwarded to the Screening and Verification Authority (SAVA) for processing. The follow up process is usually completed online. If this creates a difficulty for you please let Mary Mathew or Siobhan Rowe in the Parish Office know and we will assist you.
