## MAKE HOSPITALITY YOUR SPECIAL CARE (Rom. 12:13)



Hospitality is not only a cultural value but a Christian virtue. The Bible is full of stories which show hospitality as an encounter with God, a service to God, and a sign of the kingdom of heaven. Abraham's entertainment of the three strangers leads to the promise of a son to him and his wife in their old age, a miracle. Martha and Mary's hospitality to Jesus gives us the example of loving

attention to the presence of Jesus. The apostles' letters urge hospitality on the churches, especially the elders (I Tim 3:2; Titus 1:8; Heb 13:2; I Peter 4:9). Empathy is a strong incentive to hospitality: 'remember you were strangers in the land of Egypt' (Lev. 19:34). Hospitality is one of the marks which separate the sheep from the goats according to the vision of judgement in Matthew's Gospel (25:34-46). Even more challenging is Jesus' advice not to ask our rich friends to our dinners, but 'the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind' (Luke 14:12-14). This advice is to remind us that our good Christian works are not for our benefit but for God's glory.

And God is hospitable to us! The Eucharist, in a prayer of St Thomas Aquinas, is called 'the pledge of future glory'. At the Mass we are hosted by almighty God and fed by him. Our hospitality then, is a sign of that welcome offered by the Lord to his 'poor, crippled, lame and blind' people, who are dear to him.

We can reflect on these things as the nation is still involved in the detention of asylum seekers, and the world is troubled by the phenomenon of hordes of refugees.

### **Planned Giving**

For those who would prefer to initiate the transfer, they can contact the Parish office for our banking details.

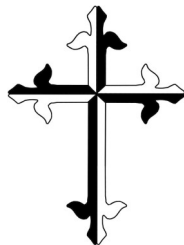
