Making progress

It is great that parishioners have been talking to me about their lives. Really, that is where pastoral care starts. I am happy to have received invitations to call in. I *will* visit parishioners at home, but I need to know when it's ok for you. (But it's hard to make time right now; there is still a lot to get used to. Although every parish is the same in some ways, in other ways so many things are done just a little bit differently, it's almost like starting all over again.)

I was really happy to celebrate four baptisms these last two weeks. It is a special time for baptism in the Easter season.

Planning has begun to celebrate the sacraments of initiation, namely Confirmation and first Holy Communion for children. More news soon.

I have taken part in the first stage of selecting a new deputy principal for the parish school. Please pray for a wise choice.

Did you notice we prayed for rain last Sunday, and look what happened! (We also prayed for a new Archbishop, but no answer - yet.)

For all the Sundays of May, the numbers of people at Mass will be counted. This is an annual requirement from the Archdiocese. So, if you see people walking up and down looking at you during Mass, relax, it is not ASIO.

May also brings Mothers' Day. Not all women are mothers, but everyone has a mother, living or dead, maybe unknown. So we can all celebrate Mothers' Day.

During May too, the St Vincent de Paul Society will hold the annual Winter Appeal. Take the envelopes when they are distributed, and return them the following Sunday.

I love the reading from John's gospel for this Sunday, especially the part where Jesus asks St Peter three times, 'do you love me?' Do you think that Peter replies a bit evasively at first? Maybe he remembered how he had denied three times that he knew Jesus, when Jesus was on trial.

Jesus understood that Peter was under threat at that time, and knew Peter's weakness. He knows all our weaknesses too, and understands how we are stressed. Jesus took all that on himself. He gives us, as he gave Peter, a chance to renew our attachment to him.

Sometimes I think I am being insincere when I pray 'I adore you', or 'I love you'; I know that a lot of the time in my life I forget to adore and love God. I have decided I *can* pray like this, by saying, 'at least right at this moment I adore you and love you'. And thank Him for that. And ask that He make me like that more often.

Youth Catechism

Question: *What does it mean to say that God is love?*

If God is love, then there is nothing created that is not carried and surrounded by his infinite benevolence. God not only declares that he is love, he also proves it: "Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends" (Jn 15:13). No other religion says what Christianity says: "God is love" (1 Jn 4:8,16). Faith holds fast to this promise, although the experience of suffering and evil in the world may make people wonder whether God is really loving. Already in the Old Testament, God communicates to his people through the words of the prophet Isaiah: "Because you are precious in my eyes, and honored, and I love you, I give men in return for you, peoples in exchange for your life. Fear not, for I am with you" (Is 43:4-5a) and has him say, "Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should have no compassion on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, yet I will not forget you. Behold, I have graven you on the palms of my hands" (Is 49:15-16a). This talk about divine love does not consist of empty words; Jesus proves this on the Cross, where he gives up his life for his friends.

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved Him. Peter was a bit offended that Jesus asked him the same thing three times. After all, Jesus knew everything- so He knew that Peter loved Him.

But think back to a few weeks ago: on Holy Thursday night some people asked Peter if he even knew Jesus, and he said "No!" three times! Maybe Jesus was trying to show Peter that it's easy to say "I love you," but it's harder to really love Him.

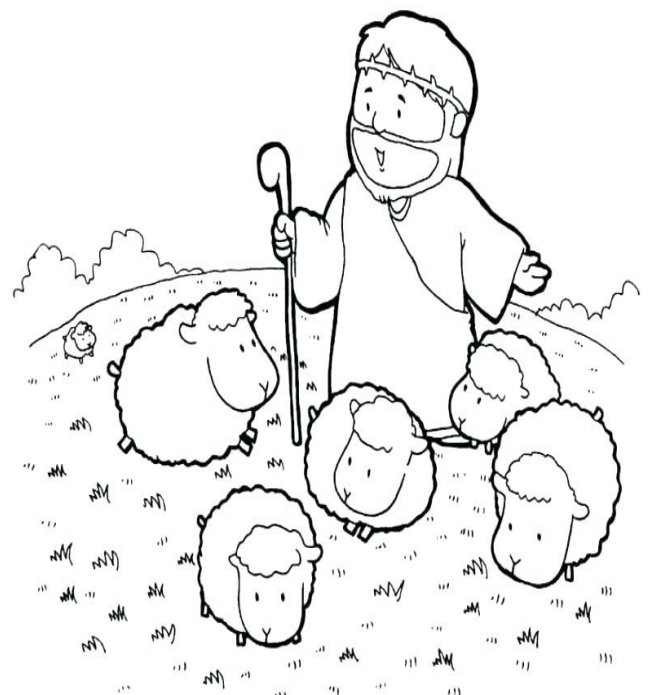
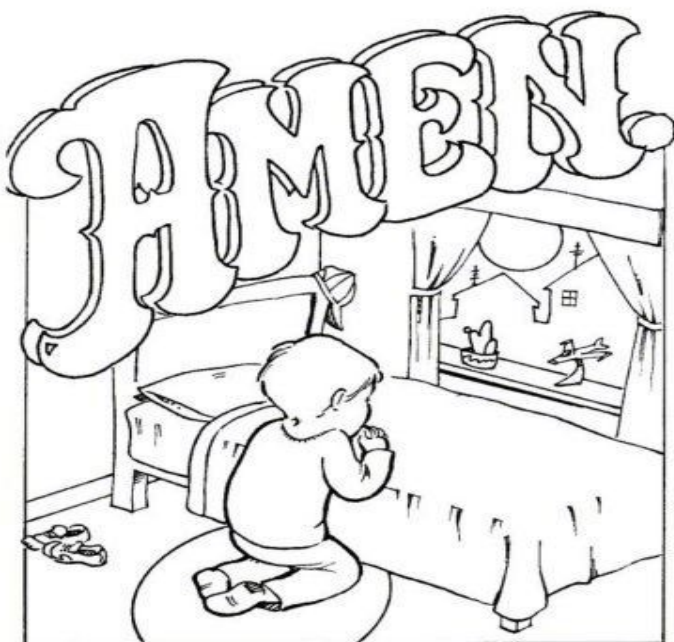
