## A Few Gems

Here is a saying attributed to **Saint Mother Teresa:**

"The fruit of silence is prayer; ..... the fruit of prayer is faith; ..... the fruit of faith is love; ..... the fruit of love is service; .....the fruit of service is peace."



**Jean Vanier**, who died during the week is quoted as saying, "Community is a sign that love is possible in a materialistic world." Jean Vanier, who founded the L'Arche movement in 1963 for people with profound disabilities, quickly learned that "normal" people have much to learn about being human by watching those we perceive as weak.



It happens that a L'Arche Community House is planned for Adelaide, and a fund-raiser film night is coming up. There is more about that in the inside pages, and on the notice board. Look for "Summer in the Forest", a documentary about two of Jean Vanier's L'Arche communities.

Something from an Easter booklet of "Five Minutes with the Word": How can you practice 'seeing' Jesus in the Eucharist more clearly? One way is to try to place all your focus on him throughout the liturgy. Before Mass begins, take a few moments to offer him the activities of your day or week... Offer him your prayer intentions as well... Give these concerns to the Lord at the beginning of Mass and try to leave them with him so that you can pay attention to the readings and the prayers... Then as you approach the altar, imagine Jesus standing before you holding all of the cares and concerns you have given him. Picture him looking at each of them with tender love and compassion. Then, as you receive him, let him give these cares and concerns back to you. Along with the bread and wine, they too have been transformed. They may look the same, but Christ is now in them. He is the living God, and he is at work, helping you face all your needs, desires, doubts, and fears.

# The Sheep and the Shepherd

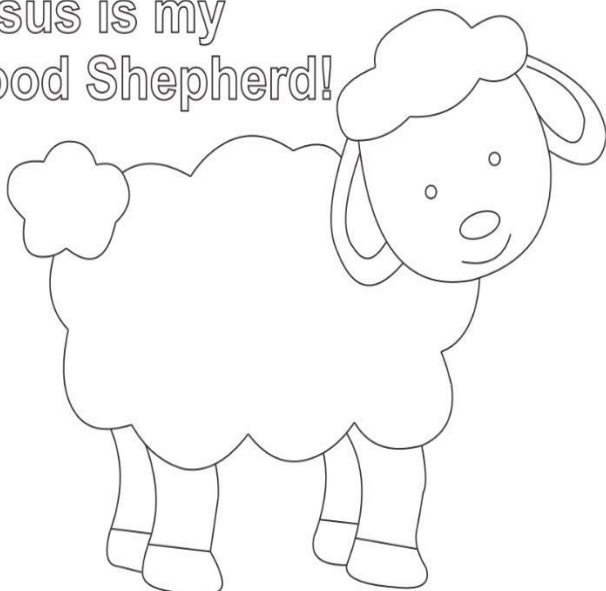
