## PARENTS ALERT! – CONFIRMATION AND FIRST EUCHARIST (HOLY COMMUNION)

If your son or daughter is in year 4, they are old enough to receive the sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Communion. You, parents, are the ones to judge if they are ready. In these sacraments they will complete their initiation into the Church of God, begun at their baptism.

They will have received at school – if they are at Rosary, Blackfriars or St Dominic's – a letter with information for you, with dates of preparation meetings, of a reflection day for the candidates and of a rehearsal, and of the celebration of the sacraments.

**To register** your child for the sacraments, there is **a form at the bottom of the letter** for you to **complete, tear off and return to the school. Please do this before Wednesday 22 May.**

If your child is **not at one of these schools**, and you wish to enrol him or her for the sacraments, **please let the parish office know by Wednesday 22 May. You will need to supply the baptism certificate of your child.**



There is a third collection at Masses today. This is for the **Winter Appeal of the St Vincent de Paul Society**. Please give generously. Vincentians fulfil the words of Our Lord, recorded in chapter 25 of St Matthew's Gospel: **"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you made me welcome, lacking clothes and you clothed me, sick and you visited me, in prison and you came to see me."** (New Jerusalem Bible)

These are Christian 'good works' and Vincentians are devoted to them. We can share in them by our financial support. We can share in them even more by doing the same works wherever we are.

By Sunday morning we will probably know the result of **the federal election**. Whatever the outcome, whether agreeable or not to you or me, we can pray for all our elected representatives. They deserve our prayers, and we need to ask God to move them to serve the common good; '... the pursuit of the common good entrusts, both to the government and the Church, care for the greatest good of all persons, not just the greatest possible number. No individual is excluded from the common good.'
