Catholic Mission - Reach Out, Give Life

You have been very good at responding to persistent appeals for your donations: to the Lebanon people after the awful explosion; to the Holy Places appeal, usually taken up on Good Friday; to the Peter's Pence appeal for the works of the Pope, usually taken in June.

Now we are asking for your continuing generosity to Catholic Mission, 'The International mission agency of the Catholic Church in Australia'. This year the focus is on Cambodia. There are few Catholics in this country but there have been great advances from a time when all religion was banned. In 1990 when religious services were allowed again '3000 Catholics were living in the country.



One of them was an older woman who had been the only Catholic in her village of Prek-Toal for fifteen years. The village is made up of houses built on bamboo rafts moored at the mouth of a river which flows from Battambang to Tonlé Sap Lake. "There were no priests, there was no Christian community to

support her. However, at Christmas she gathered her neighbours together to celebrate the birth of Jesus with her," explained missionary Father Totet Banaynaz. Since then, a mobile floating church has been built. Fifty baptized people live in the village and each year, a growing number of children and adults are preparing themselves for baptism and Holy Communion.'

Bishop Schmitthaeusler, Apostolic Vicar for the Cambodian capital of Phnom Penh: "When I arrived here, it was Christmastime, and I thought that it would be good to enact the Christmas story... I then realised that the time was right for big stage productions and to begin with what I would call evangelisation through art.... Art runs in the blood of the Cambodian people. For all of the people here, both children and adults, it is absolutely natural to dance and to sing," the bishop said, explaining how the rich artistic and cultural heritage of Cambodia could be used for evangelisation purposes.' Evangelisation is also carried on by Christian charity. The need is greater because of the explosion of land mines laid during the conflicts of the 1970s 80s and 90s. Catholic Mission appeals to you to 'help empower children and young adults with disability at the Arrupe Centre in Cambodia, which provides vital care for those who would otherwise have limited opportunities or support to lead a fulfilling life.' https://www.catholicmission.org.au/
