Loving Our Neighbour as Ourselves



Last week I highlighted some associations offering counselling to women with an unexpected or unwanted pregnancy. Another one which I contacted during the week urged me to get parishioners writing letters to Rachel Sanderson, MP for Adelaide and Minister for Child Protection. You can contact her by email:

Ask her to vote against the Termination of Pregnancy Bill, currently before the Legislative Council.

The Bishops of SA have said that this Bill 'would further increase the rate of abortion on demand and put vulnerable women at greater risk of economic and social coercion.

"We believe the focus of politicians should be to improve emotional, financial and systematic supports so women are wholly supported," Archbishop O'Regan said.

"The feedback from counselling services is that many women are struggling with the decision to keep their baby because of external pressures, anxiety about how they will cope and fear of being a parent.

"The impact post-abortion can be ongoing disappointment, anger, abandonment and subsequent mental health issues."

I like the Bishops' message. It could be the basis of our letters to Rachel Sanderson, or other SA politicians.

Writing to our MP on this issue is fulfilling the second commandment which resembles the first, as in our Gospel passage read today. Remembering this will mean, too, that our messages will be respectful.


We look forward to big things from them for Christ and the Church in the years ahead.

This is all part of our belief and belonging to the Communion of Saints. Put simply, the Communion of Saints is the spiritual union which binds the living and the dead.

The names on the envelopes will be added to the Remembrance Book and Masses will be offered for those in the Remembrance Book collectively. Individual names will not be called out during mass. The Greatest Commandment
