Ash Wednesday this week – 2 March



Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent. Lent asks us to accompany Jesus in his suffering humanity by our own penance, especially Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving (sharing our worldly goods.) This is to prepare us to rejoice in his gift of himself in the Eucharist on Holy Thursday (April 14), share his suffering on Good Friday (April 15), and exult in his triumph at the Easter Vigil (April 16) and on Easter Sunday (April 17).

Ash Wednesday is a day to be sparing in what we eat and drink, and not to eat meat. Pope Francis has asked "I invite everyone to make March 2, Ash Wednesday, a day of fasting for peace," he said. "I encourage believers in a special way to devote themselves intensely to prayer and fasting on that day. May the Queen of Peace protect the world from the folly of war." The Pope has Ukraine especially in mind.

On Ash Wednesday there will be Mass with imposition of ashes at both Rosary Church and St Laurence's Church, at midday. At St Laurence's there will be a Liturgy of the Word with imposition of ashes at 7.30 pm. The ashes will be sprinkled on the head, rather than applied to the forehead.

This Sunday, the Caritas Project Compassion envelopes and collection boxes are available. The collection boxes can be returned on Holy Thursday or Good Friday.



It looks like the **Eight Gospel Pathways** consultation needs more explanation. 

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday is the first day in the season of Lent. If you go to Mass on Ash Wednesday, the priest may sprinkle a small amount of ashes on your head or forehead.

Lent can be observed by all Christians, and it is a beautiful way to remember Jesus' sacrifice for us and prepare us for the Easter season. During Lent, we remember the 40 days that Jesus spent in the desert being tempted by the devil. We do extra prayers, fasting, and almsgiving during this season of Lent.
