

Thank you to those who joined in the Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Friday

Let us not cease to pray for peace, and to strengthen our prayer with our repentance, and renew our Lenten penance of prayer, fasting and almsgiving (good works). The announcement of the Act of Consecration from Pope Francis reminds us 'it is fitting that we should invoke peace with hearts renewed by God's forgiveness.' The Act of Consecration itself includes a litary of repentance. We cannot expect a kind response from our Lord if our own hearts are not devoted to him, and his Mother. God is merciful, but not to be taken for granted.

Note this from the Archdiocese: The 2022 Marian Procession will be held on Sunday May 22 at the Adelaide Showgrounds. This year, in support of the Ukrainian community, the image that will lead our procession is Vyshhorodska - Mother of God. The Procession will commence at 2pm and all are invited to attend with their parish or community. Does our parish have a banner to carry in procession? Let's have a parish group in the procession.

Sometimes you and I make bad choices -- just like the young man in today's Gospel. We sometimes wish for things that are not good for us. We sometimes don't want to listen to God and obey what the Bible tells us we should do. When we act that way, we really make a mess of our life. Well, there is good news! Just like the father in our story, God, our Heavenly Father, is always willing to take us back if we will admit that we were wrong and return to Him.

Dear Father, we sometimes make bad choices. Thank you for being a loving Father who will always take us back when we come home to you. Amen.
