A MOMENTOUS TIME

By the time you read this, about 50 of our young people will have celebrated the sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. This is the first public step in their Catholic spiritual journey since their baptism. Some have been prevented by Covid, but will be provided with this sacrament separately when they are well. Congratulations and blessings to all of them, and to the teachers and catechists who have prepared them. Thanks to the priests who have been the ministers of this sacrament.

Palm Sunday, today, is the beginning of Holy Week. The week ends with the Paschal Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil, leading to Easter Sunday. These are the holiest days of the year. We can benefit from them by participating in the liturgies and other prayers and by reflecting on the mysteries presented there. These mysteries are where we know our salvation. We know our freedom from death and sin, being made more perfect to live fully the new life born at our baptism.

Remember the Diocesan Assembly? Remember the Plenary Council? Did you take part or make submissions? Did you make submissions for the forthcoming Synod of Bishops in Rome? The Archbishop has written reminding us of these events. They are an ongoing work of discerning the work of the Holy Spirit in the church in Australia. You can take part in the presentation of the Diocesan report to the Synod of Bishops. The presentation will take place on April 30 at 1.45 at The Monastery, Glen Osmond. Space is limited. Booking essential: www.trybooking.com/BYLPR The event will also be livestreamed. And the next Diocesan Assembly will be on 22 October. From May to July 2022, communities across the Archdiocese will be invited to reflect upon the Diocesan Recommendations and provide feedback.

On Good Friday there will be the usual collection for the work of the Franciscans in caring for Christians and their shrines in the Holy Land. This work cares for people in many different ways: education, hospital care, care for orphans, refugees, and parishes. This work relies to a large extent on your offerings on Good Friday.

On Palm Sunday we remember Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. How would you think such an important person came into the town? Limo? Fancy carriage? No, He came on a donkey! This showed that He was coming humbly and in peace. Also, by coming on a donkey, Jesus was doing something that a prophet had predicted long before He was even born. That showed God was following through on His big plans. Now, while Jesus was coming into Jerusalem, people lined up to welcome Him. They put their coats on the ground, sort of like a fancy red carpet, but also to show that the people respected Jesus and considered Him their king. They waved palm branches, which were a sign of respect, and were also a sign of victory. They shouted "Hosanna!" which means "save us."
