## **'You alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, ...'**

The meaning of these words may help to explain the sayings of Jesus in the Gospel passage read today. They are familiar to us as the ending of the hymn, the 'Gloria', sung or recited at Mass. They express faith in the uniqueness of Jesus. Jesus has no rival or competitor. To follow him, become his disciple, means accepting him, and no one else, and nothing else, as the Lord of my life. Jesus is not one option amongst many others. To choose Jesus means giving second place to all others.

Jesus seems to discourage the man who volunteered to follow him. 'The Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head'. It's as if Jesus says, 'Don't kid yourself that this is a soft option. If you are looking for a comfortable life, think again.'

Jesus tells another man not to attend to his father's burial. That's a serious obligation in any culture. For the Jews it was a religious obligation. So it is for Christians. (One of the corporal works of mercy.) So, Jesus won't be telling this person not to bother about his duty to his family. But he declares that every act of ours, body or mind, is to be devoted to him, Jesus, and his mission. He deserves such an unqualified response. It is the only suitable response to his love. He wants nothing but the best for us.

Family life is not to be 'self-indulgent'. It is for the announcing of the good news of the coming of God's kingdom. It is to be 'led by the Spirit', in the words of St Paul's letter, also read today. Being led by the Spirit leads to self-mastery. Not to be led by the Spirit leads to slavery to our instincts and feelings. Self-mastery is a goal for every human being. Most of us find it slips out of our grasp just when we think we have gained it. The Spirit of God wants to make this goal not only reachable for this life, but fruitful for eternal life. That gives a sense of urgency doesn't it? Fear of missing out? No wonder Jesus' demands were uncompromising.

- Baptism preparation is to be provided to families by parishioners. Volunteers needed.

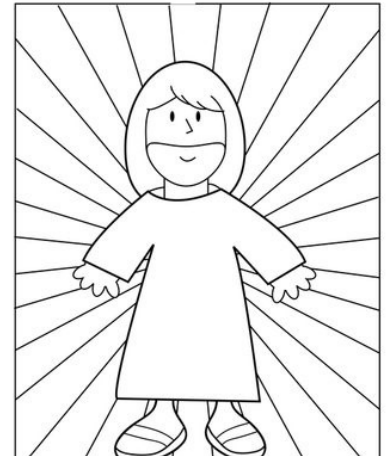

In the Gospel, Jesus talked about what it means to follow Him. Jesus said that if we want to follow Him, we need to be willing to put aside everything else. We don't want anything to come between our lives and His love. That is the reason Jesus asks us to follow Him. It isn't that He wants us to abandon our families or give up nice things. But He has a love and a plan for us that are better than anything else we could try to put our hope in. And how do we know we are following Him?



We can read His words, of course, in the Bible. We can pray, and ask for guidance in recognizing and following His instructions. It isn't always easy at first, but we can rest assured that it is the best thing for us, because it is what He asked. He has our best interests in mind, whether we understand immediately or not!
