

Corpus Christi, aka The Body and Blood of Christ.



This is one of the leading feasts of the Church. It is celebrated at this time of the year, following closely after Easter, Ascension and Trinity. It celebrates the greatest gift of God – himself, to be our food of eternal life, given through Jesus' dying and rising again.

I have a request: When you receive Holy Communion, you should hear the minister say 'The Body of Christ', right? Well, the minister should hear **you** say, 'Amen'.

It's not such a huge thing, is it? And yet there are many who don't say it. Why am I making such a fuss, like, every year? Well, I wonder what is in the minds of

people. Are they believers? Do they value what they are receiving? Will they treat the sacrament of the Lord reverently? I wonder, if you are not prepared to do this little thing, are you prepared to do anything for Jesus? If someone said to you, 'take ten thousand dollars', would you respond in silence? The minister is supposed to give the sacrament to someone who is 'properly disposed'? How can we tell? Hearing the reply 'Amen' is one of the ways.

This is what St Augustine wrote: 'You are saying "Amen" to what you are: your response is a personal signature, affirming your faith. When you hear "The body of Christ", you reply "Amen." Be a member of Christ's body, then, so that your "Amen" may ring true!'

Some of our young people are beginning soon to prepare for the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist. By this they will complete their Christian Initiation in the Catholic Church. Pray for them and their catechists, parents, and godparents - and give them good example.

re-enactment of the Last Supper, the final meal that Jesus Christ shared with his disciples.

At the Last Supper, Jesus changed bread and wine into His own Body and Blood. He has the power to do this because he is God. He did this because He wanted to stay with us even after he went to Heaven.

Jesus comes to us in every Mass. The priest takes the place of Jesus, saying the words that Jesus said at the Last Supper, and the bread and wine become the real Body and Blood, Soul Divinity of Jesus even though they still look like bread and wine.
