What is the Holy Spirit like?



St Luke, writing the Acts of the Apostles, says the Spirit is like a powerful wind and flaming tongues.

This fire made the tongues of the Apostles burn with words to speak what God wanted. Their inhibitions and fears were swept away by this gale. The powerful wind blew breath from their mouths to announce Good News.

The Spirit animated the Apostles to do things which they never knew they could, or even wanted to. They seemed just to react to the experience of the Spirit. But when challenged, they knew what they had to do. They explained to the listeners what the death and Resurrection of Jesus meant. The Spirit worked through them to touch the consciences of their hearers. The hearers knew that they were guilty and asked what they could do about it. They were told to be baptized, and they were, immediately, thousands of them.

The Apostles learned to live by the Spirit, putting away life according to 'the flesh' (the material world, on its own terms). What they did, or said, was what the Spirit wanted them to do or say. The results were what the Spirit wanted. They began to do the same things that Jesus had done. They cured the sick, raised the dead – and also were glad to die insisting on the truth. They taught the ignorant, they opposed the self-righteous. They learned as they went along. They talked amongst themselves, reflecting on what they had done, remembering what Jesus had done.

Their authority was the Holy Spirit. They knew that their decisions were subject to the Holy Spirit. They knew, because of the Psalms and other scriptures, that the Advocate would make the whole of creation new. It was not to be a place of sin, but a place of God's glory. They were the ones to call people to open their eyes to see the new creation before them.

The Holy Spirit is still at work in the Apostles of the Lamb, you and me. We are to live in the Spirit, not the 'flesh'.

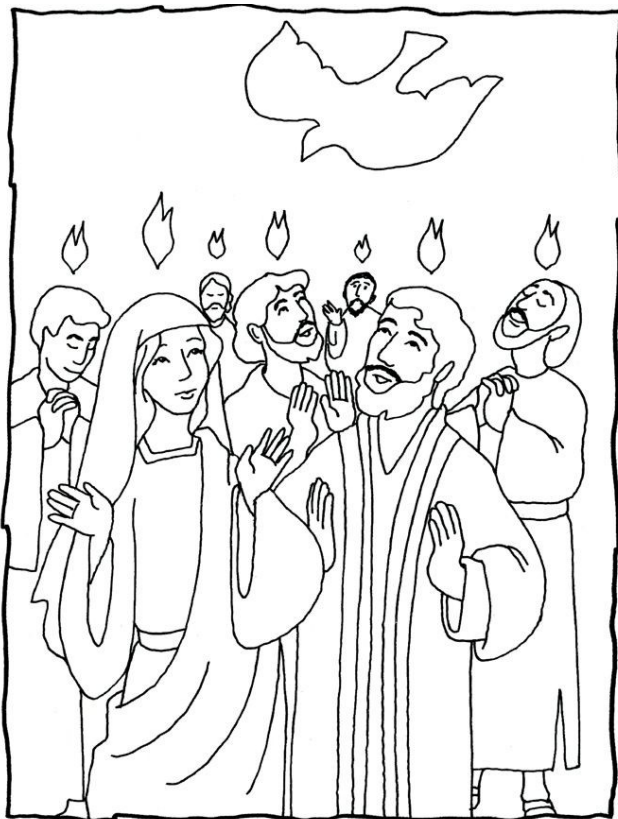
PENTECOST
