#### AID TO THE CHURCH IN NEED

Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) is 'a Catholic foundation dedicated to the pastoral and spiritual needs of suffering, oppressed and persecuted Christians.' Its aid reaches further than that given by other organisations.


For example, Aid to the Church in Need will provide formation of seminarians and priests, 'existence help' for religious sisters, emergency assistance for Christian refugees, distribution of Bibles and religious books, education of catechists, construction of churches and church facilities, rebuilding of destroyed churches, transport for pastoral care, media support for the propagation of the faith, etc.

These are projects that will not be on the priority list of governments, of humanitarian or philanthropic organizations, but will likely be ignored by them.

ACN reaches those whose only means of support is other Christians. ACN seeks donations, sells devotional articles and accepts Mass offerings for priests whose people cannot afford to give offerings. This includes offerings for 'Gregorian Masses'.

#### WHAT HAPPENS AT MASS?



Each week I intend to insert a short quotation from an excellent book called 'What Happens at Mass'. I want to do so because, like the author of the book, Dom Jeremy Driscoll OSB, I think many Catholics do not know. You may know, but your children or grandchildren may not. Could you explain it to them? I hope these excerpts may help. Here is an extract from the introduction:

'Something happens at Mass. God is acting! He acts to save us. It is a huge event. In fact, there is nothing bigger. God has concentrated the entirety of his saving love for the world into the ritual action and words of the eucharistic liturgy'.

## TOGETHER ON THE WAY

Please keep in prayer the preparations in the Archdiocese of Adelaide for the next Diocesan Assembly, on 22 October. The parish reflection on the first Assembly will take place on Saturday 25 June. It will be a big task to sift through multiple recommendations and determine priorities for the mission of the Archdiocese.

The next session of the Australian Plenary Council, will be held in Sydney in July. Both the Assembly and the Council will look towards the 2023 Synod of the bishops of the world. The focus of this Synod is 'synodality' itself, the move towards more inclusive participation at all levels of the church.

This requires careful discernment, and above all, prayers – especially yours!

As simple as that sounds, the Trinity is hard to understand. The three persons in the Blessed Trinity are all equal but different. We cannot understand this, but we believe it because Jesus taught it. It is a mystery to us - something we can think about and wonder about. People have used many different things to try and help explain what the Trinity is. Take for example, an egg. It has three parts- the shell, the white and the yolk, but together it makes up an egg.



Let's pray:

God, we thank you for being all-powerful and all-knowing and for loving us. We thank you for the things in life that we don't completely understand and for giving us the faith to believe them anyway. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy spirit, Amen.
