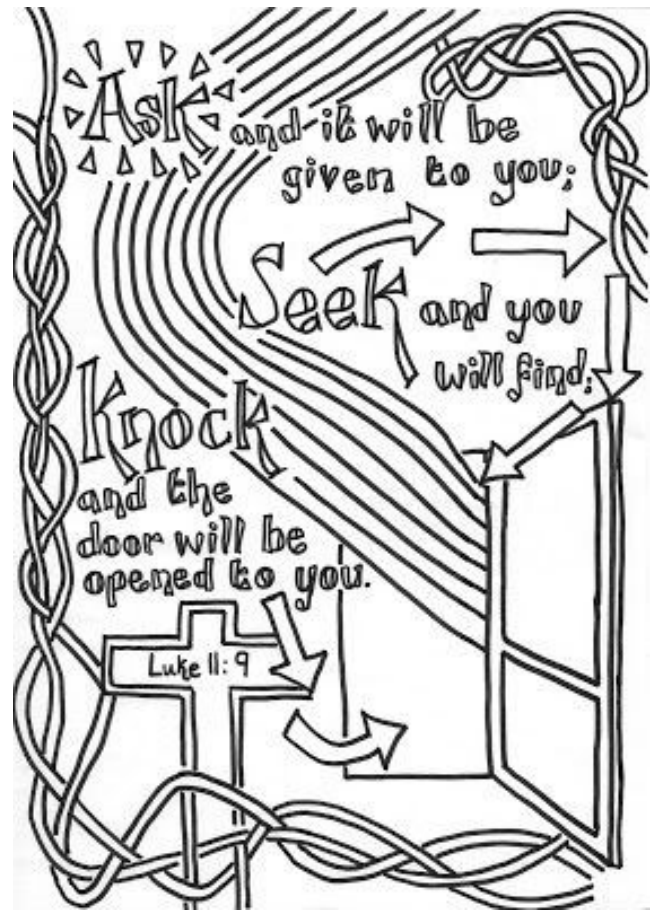

Jesus Teaches us to Pray

Prayer is not magic or hard to understand. Prayer is just talking to God like he's your best friend, because He is if you have been saved. We have the best teacher to show us how to pray: Jesus in Luke—chapter 11. The disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray so He taught them the "Our Father".

In the first part of the "Our Father", we give glory to God by praising Him, and in the second part we ask Him for the things we need. These things can be spiritual or physical things like food. Next we ask for forgiveness for our sins and for God to keep us away from evil and temptations.

Jesus said that if a father on earth would give his children the things they need, then God, who is our Father in Heaven, will certainly give us what we need. All He wants us to do is show that we trust in Him by asking Him.

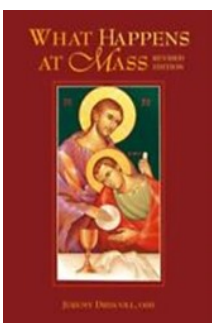

We are Called to Trust each other with Ourselves

Trust is the theme for today and as married couples we are called to trust each other enough to become 'two in one flesh'. We need to listen sensitively to one another and to share our innermost thoughts, feelings, hopes, dreams, joys, sorrows, worries and anxieties in such a way that we might both be fully human and fully alive.

Continuing the series 'What happens at Mass': The Mass is a ritual, and this means that it requires initiation, repetition, a sense of performance.... The ritual is a form and the form delivers a content – not an intellectual content to be grasped with the mind, but an actual event, nothing less than the very event of our salvation.... the ritual takes us out of ourselves and beyond ourselves. It lets God act and gives us a way of acting in response. We don't have to invent the response, coming up with it on the spot.... Instead the ritual gives us a response adequate to the mystery of what the ritual has also delivered; namely, God's own saving action. (pg.vii)
