WHERE YOUR TREASURE IS, THERE YOUR HEART WILL BE ALSO!



You can support the preaching of the Gospel by contributing to the livelihood of the priests, and to the expenses of the parish. For these needs we have two collections at weekend Masses.

The **FIRST COLLECTION** is taken immediately after the homily. This is for the support of the **PRIESTS**: our food, housing, clothing, transport, health insurance, repairs, maintenance and insurance of our house, housekeeping and cleaning expenses, telephone, power, water, gas for our home.

The priests are managing, thanks to your contributions to the **FIRST COLLECTION**.

The **SECOND COLLECTION** is taken after the Prayers of the Faithful. This is for the expenses of the **PARISH**: all that is needed for worship – bread, wine, books, vestments, candles; for our equipment of the parish office; for the ongoing repair and maintenance of the churches, the parish office and hall; for insurance, cleaning, diocesan taxes, staff wages and superannuation, water, gas, power, telephone and IT, accounting and bookkeeping expenses, photocopying.

The parish is losing money every week, because the **SECOND COLLECTION** is less than our expenses.

When we repaired Rosary Church, we were able to pay for it out of reserves. We cannot build up reserves again while we are not meeting our weekly expenses.

If you can give more to the **SECOND COLLECTION**, that will benefit the parish. **ELECTRONIC GIVING** There are options for electronic giving. These are especially useful for parishioners who do not carry cash and for parishioners who do not come to church on Sunday.

First, you can authorize a direct debit, or a credit card payment. These are for the **SECOND COLLECTION** only. Forms for these are in the porches of the churches now. Collect one, or ask the parish office to mail you one. Contact details are on the front page of Dominews.

Second, there is the Archdiocese of Adelaide 'Find a Mass' app. It includes a feature for electronic giving. The app is free from the App Store, or Google Play. The advantage of it is that it allows for giving to both collections, and also for special collections. Some parishioners are using this already. There is more information on the website of the Catholic Archdiocese of Adelaide.

Remember: **FIRST** collection – **PRIESTS** (managing)
SECOND collection – **PARISH** (NOT managing)
