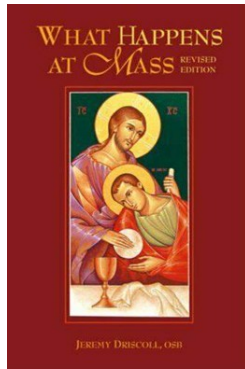

“The Mysteries”



‘From the time of the apostles, the Christian community celebrated the rites of Baptism and Eucharist in obedience to the Lord’s commands. (Mt 28:19; Lk 22:19) From as early as the second century, these rites were referred to as mysteries. But why?

A deep intuition and insight is carried in the application of this word to those ritual practices. The roots of this intuition lie in the theology of St Paul, who used the word mystery as a key concept in his whole understanding of the cross, in his whole understanding of what had happened in Christ.

For St Paul the central mystery is the cross of Christ.

But why does he call the cross a mystery? He does so to express that something was hidden in the cross which we cannot understand without its being revealed....In fact the entire plan of God for the world is hidden in the cross.

So it is that Paul can announce the Christian message as the gift of being given ‘the wisdom to understand fully the mystery, the plan he was pleased to decree in Christ.’ What that plan is, was not plain to any and all who looked at Christ, and so it is a mystery.

But to those who understand the mystery, it was nothing less than ‘all things in heaven and on earth recapitulated in Christ’ (Eph 1:9-10)

Christ himself is called ‘the mystery of God’ because ‘in him every treasure of wisdom and knowledge is hidden’ (Col 2:2-3)

So, always something hidden but now something also revealed.
I think the following is a fair way of summarizing the huge world of thought that swirls around his use of the word mystery...I would say that a mystery is a concrete something that when you bump into it, it puts you in contact with a divine reality.

(These edited extracts from the book, ‘What happens at Mass’, by Dom Jeremy Driscoll OSB, are offered as an ongoing study of the rites of the Mass. In this way I hope to help our congregations at Mass to participate more freely in the liturgy.

BTW, I insist on spelling Mass with a capital ‘M’, which emphasizes that it is a proper name, not a common noun, which refers to a scientific concept of matter. Fr Paul)

The Narrow Door

In our Bible lesson today, Jesus tells about people who will be knocking at the door. Where is the door Jesus is talking about? It is the door to heaven. Everyone wants to get into heaven, but there is only one door and Jesus says the door is very narrow. Jesus said, "Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to. Once the owner of the house gets up and closes the door, you will stand outside knocking and pleading, 'Sir, open the door for us.' "But he will answer, 'I don't know you or where you come from. Get away from me.'"

Does that sound harsh to you? Where is that narrow door that we must find and how do we enter in? You may remember that Jesus once told a story about the good shepherd. In that parable, Jesus said, "I am the door: by me if any man enters in, he will be saved." (John 10:9 KJV) There is only one door to enter into heaven and that door is Jesus. Who can enter that door? Anyone! If we put our faith and trust in him, we won't be left standing outside knocking and crying, "Let me in."

Here is one more knock, knock joke for you:
Knock, knock. (Who's there?) Orange.
(Orange who?) Orange you glad to know that Jesus is the door to heaven?
