God Wants Everyone to Come Back to Him

In today's Gospel we hear three parables. In the first Jesus talks about the shepherd who lost one of his hundred sheep. But even though he had so many, he still cared about the one that was lost and went out to find it. God is like that too: even though He has so many people to look after He still cares about you in particular.

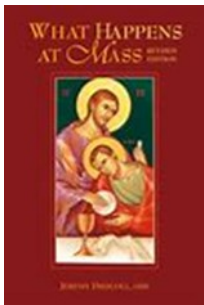
The next parable is similar, with the woman searching all over her house when she loses one of her special coins. She rejoices when she finds it, just like the angels rejoice in Heaven when a sinner turns back to God. The last parable that Jesus tells is the story of the prodigal son. We are like the son in that story when we run away from God by sinning. But like the father, God is waiting and watching for us to be sorry and come back to Him. All we have to do is tell Him we are sorry for our sins in Confession and He will be so happy to have us back!

Driving Together on the Way to Heaven

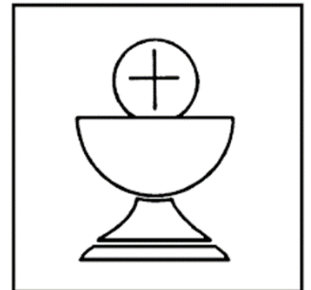

The Mystery of the Assembly

In the coming together of many people into one place to pray under the headship of their bishop or a priest, we have an acting out in a very concrete way of what the Church is meant to be.

The Greek word for church is *ekklesia*.... Literally in Greek it means 'a calling out' and 'a calling together.' So, *church* means those called out from somewhere by God and called together into one place by Him. ... So, people just coming to the church building is already a mystery.
