Grace and peace, I hope this note finds you well. As we prepare for the 2022 Diocesan Assembly in October 2022, I invite every Parish, School and Community to use the Diocesan Assembly Prayer at every opportunity including Masses and regular gatherings.

The 2022 Diocesan Assembly is a continuation of the work that was started at the 2021 Assembly. In 2021 participants developed recommendations for local Parishes, Schools, Communities, Agencies and for the Archdiocese as a whole. These recommendations need to be further discerned by the local Communities and Diocesan Leadership. The 2022 Diocesan Assembly will build on the 2021 recommendations and provide opportunities for formation, skill-building, and strategic planning. It will also be an opportunity to look at the results of the Plenary Council and how they will be incorporated into local and Diocesan life. Assemblies will become a regular fixture of Diocesan life.

At least one more annual Assembly is planned for 2023. After that, assemblies may occur every other year with Parish or Deanery Assemblies encouraged on the alternate years.

The 2022 Diocesan Assembly agenda will be informed by:

- The 2021 Diocesan Assembly recommendations and subsequent feedback
- The discernment of the Diocesan Pastoral Council
- Plenary Council outcomes

So please join me in praying as we move towards the Diocesan Assembly.

Don't Forget to Thank God!

In today's Gospel we hear a story about people with leprosy. Leprosy is a disease that causes sores all over the body. It was very common in Jesus' day, and people who had this disease were thought to be dirty and unclean. They were required to stay away from other people because of the fear that they might infect them with their disease.

One day, Jesus was walking through a small village when He saw a group of ten lepers. They stood far away from Jesus and called to Him, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us." Obviously, they knew who Jesus was and that He had the power to heal them. When Jesus heard them. He called back to the lepers and said, "Go, show yourself to the priest."

As the lepers went on their way to see the priest, they looked at their skin and the sores were gone. Jesus had healed their disease. They were so happy that they ran up and down the streets singing and dancing. Suddenly, one of them stopped and went back. Praising God with a loud voice, he threw himself at Jesus' feet and said, "Thank You." Jesus said to him, "Weren't there ten who were healed? Where are the other nine?" (Luke 17:11-19) Only one out of ten remembered to say, "Thank You."

God does so much for us! Every day He provides everything we need: food, clothing, and a place to live. Do we ever forget to say, "Thank You?"

Let's stop right now and say, "Thank You," and ask God to help us remember to thank Him every day.
