To celebrate this time of the year, Catholic Mission is launching #wearestillhere, a 2022 campaign reflecting on the role of being a missionary.




MORNING TEA

THE ASSEMBLY (contd.) 'In the eucharistic celebration itself, many elements express the divine nature of the reality that is occurring; indeed, these elements are the very means of embodying and ensuring the particular and precise nature of what is happening; namely, that **Christ** is acting and that the community is entirely defined and comes into being only through what he does


and accomplishes. Thus, for example, in the person of the bishop or priest **Christ** is represented as the head of this assembly. It is he who gathers it; it is under his authority that it stands; it is his word that is gratefully heard and pondered; it is together with him that the community will dare to speak a word back to the Father and make its thanksgiving offering to him.' (P.9. Emphasis added)

Be Humble

Jesus told about two men who went to the temple. A temple is like a church. One of the men bragged about all of the great things he did and thanked God that he wasn't like those other sinners in the temple.

The other man, instead of bragging about how great he was, humbly asked God to forgive him for all of the times he failed to be the kind of person that God wanted him to be.

This man knew that he could never do enough good things to be as high as God. This man knew that he needed God. Jesus was not the least bit impressed with all of the bragging of the first man. After all, when we compare our goodness to the goodness of Jesus, it just doesn't stack up, does it?
