'I believe in the Communion of Saints'

This we affirm every Sunday in the Apostles Creed.

Here is what 'The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church' says about the Communion of Saints:

195. What else does 'the communion of saints' mean?

This expression also refers to the communion between holy persons; that is, between those who by grace are united to the dead and risen Christ. Some are pilgrims on the earth; others, having passed from this life, are undergoing purification and are helped also by our prayers. Others already enjoy the glory of God and intercede for us. All of these together form in Christ one family, the Church, to the praise and glory of the Trinity.

211. How can we help the souls being purified in purgatory?

Because of the communion of saints, the faithful who are still pilgrims on earth are able to help the souls in purgatory by offering prayers in suffrage for them, especially the Eucharistic sacrifice. They also help them by almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance.

So, 210. What is purgatory?

Purgatory is the state of those who die in God's friendship, assured of their eternal salvation, but who still have need of purification to enter into the happiness of heaven.

And, 312. What are indulgences?

Indulgences are the remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven. The faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains the indulgence under prescribed conditions for either himself or the departed. Indulgences are granted through the ministry of the Church which, as the dispenser of the grace of redemption, distributes the treasury of the merits of Christ and the Saints.

You can gain a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory by visiting a church on 2 November, or a cemetery between 1 and 8 November, and praying the Lord's Prayer and the Creed for the dead. The conditions to gain a plenary indulgence are to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist and being free from all attachment to sin.



MARRIAGE MATTERS

The Call to Praise and Affirm Each Other

Jesus affirmed Zacchaeus by going to his house for a meal. How often is our focus on what we want our spouse to do rather than on how can we bring him/her life and joy? A daily reflection on where we need ask for forgiveness and on how we can affirm our spouse for something, brings us both new life.



THE ASSEMBLY (contd.) '.. in the Eucharist the one time and place of a particular gathering ... are made to contain in this particular form the mystery of the universal Church across the world and across the centuries and across the heavens extending to the community of the saints and angels in heaven. ... The local reality is an icon in which the

reality of the universal Church is rendered present. It is for this reason that in the eucharistic prayer the local bishop is named, as is the bishop of Rome, with whom the local bishop and bishops across the world verify their communion and apostolic faith. The saints in heaven are named, and the dead are remembered. The year of the celebration is etched boldly on the Easter candle which dominates the sanctuary. All this is contained in the language and cultural forms of the particular place. (pp. 9-10)

Today's Bible lesson is about a short tax collector named Zacchaeus who wanted to

catch a glimpse of Jesus when he came to town. Because he was short, he had to climb a tree to see! When Jesus came by and saw Zacchaeus in the tree, Jesus looked up at him and called him by name. Jesus knew his name! And Jesus knows your name. Jesus said. "Zacchaeus! Come down quickly. I am going to be a guest in your home today." And Zaccaheus took Jesus to his house. The people could not believe that Jesus would go to the home of a man like that!

Jesus changed Zacchaeus. And Zacchaeus said, "I am going to give half of all that I own to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."

Jesus forgave Zacchaeus and said, "Today salvation has come to this house. For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost." Jesus knew Zacchaeus' name. And he knew everything Zacchaeus had ever done. When Zacchaeus met Jesus, his life was changed. It doesn't matter if you are short or tall, Jesus knows your name, too, and Jesus knows everything about you.

Dear God, we know that when we meet Jesus, it will be a life-changing experience. Thank You that Jesus knows our name and loves us. In Jesus' name, amen.
