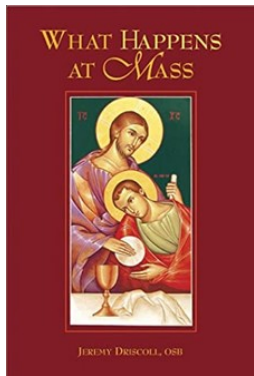

THE SHAPE OF THE RITE
'Two basic movements define its essential form, .. from God the Father to the world', and 'from the world to God the Father'. 'These two directions unfold in both a Trinitarian and an ecclesial shape.The first movement in this shape can be described as follows: the Father gives Himself through the Son in the Holy Spirit. ... God

the Father gives Himself to the world by giving His Son ...The Father gives His Son in and by the Holy Spirit who is the Spirit of the Father. The Father gives His Spirit an assignment, as it were; namely, ... that the Son be known and that all who believe in him might live their lives entirely from the Son's life. It is this precise trinitarian form that is revealed in what happens at Mass; ... that the Father gives Himself to the world in the giving of His Son, a Son at every moment accompanied by the action and work of the Holy Spirit.
