Fr Peter is joining our Dominican Friars community at North Adelaide. He is to take up the position of chaplain at Blackfriars Priory School. He has been parish priest in the Dominican parish in Melbourne for several years. He was also parish priest here at North Adelaide/Prospect some years ago. Many of you will remember him from those days.

CLAIM THE DATE! On Friday 3 March, 10am, Rosary Church Hall, we will celebrate the World Day of Prayer. What is it? The World Day of Prayer is an international ecumenical Christian laywomen's initiative. We will be joining with the members of Prospect Uniting Church and St Cuthbert's Anglican Church. More details later. If you want to know more in the meantime, search for 'World Day of Prayer Australia'.

You know I want to help parishioners find resources for development of faith and prayer. There are many options available online. One that is thoroughly local is found at: <https://harvestersplace.com.au> This is from the Catholic Church of South Australia. There is a great range of opportunities on this page: prayer, scripture, apps and podcasts - including 'the Pope page' with tweets and prayer intentions from Pope Francis. There are links to prayer support from local people and groups. There is inspiration from leading teachers around the world. One worth mentioning is 'Word on Fire', from Bishop Robert Barron. Those of you who join in the Rosary before the Sunday evening Mass will have heard from him.

Another Australian source is 'The Well' from the Sydney diocese of Parramatta. I think Bishop Long of Parramatta is one of Australia's creative bishops. (Another is Bishop Greg Homeming, O. Carm, of Lismore) The Well speaks of his desire to bring the Gospel of Christ to many people. The Well is also informing the Catholic faithful. Amongst other things there are two interesting videos on the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. If you or your children are going to be involved in these sacraments this year, go check them out.

Lastly, some parishioners recommend the podcasts of Fr Mike Schmitz, a dynamic American priest whose talks are available on Youtube and Spotify. I am told that you can slow him down! – he talks very fast – by a setting on the app.

While all these depend on you to go and get them, there are some services which can be held in one of our churches. We will do that later in the year, after the Sacraments of Initiation are completed.

Going Fishing!

Our Bible lesson today has something to do with fishing. One day, Jesus was walking along the seashore when he saw two brothers named Peter and Andrew. Jesus knew they made their living by fishing, so He called out to them, "Follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" Do you know what they did? They laid down their fishing nets and followed Jesus.

Jesus wants you and me to fish for people, too. That means that Jesus wants us to tell others about what He has done for us and what He wants to do for them. Fishing for people is a lot like fishing for fish.

First, we need to be properly equipped. We need to know what the Bible teaches and learn how to share it with others. Next, we go out where the people are and tell them about Jesus. Finally, we must be patient. If we will do these things, we can really become fishers of people like Jesus wants us to be. If you think there is a great feeling of excitement in catching a fish, just imagine how exciting it must be to bring someone to Jesus!

Dear Jesus, help us become fishers of people. Help us tell others what You have done for us and what you want to do for them. In Jesus' name, amen.!
