Saturday 2 September: Quiz night, after the evening Mass.

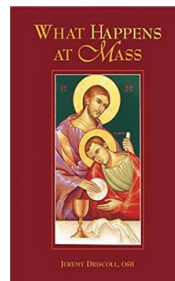

THE OLD TESTAMENT READING

At the end of the proclamation of the passage, the reader bluntly declares what it is that we have just heard: 'The word of the Lord'. .. this is like a great shout, a trumpet call. The declaration should be heard with absolute amazement. How absurd it would be to take for granted that God should speak in our midst. We are expressing our amazement, and we are saying that we do not take it for granted when we cry out from the depths of our hearts, 'Thanks be to God'. (pp 40-41)
