NATIONAL VOCATIONS AWARENESS WEEK



'You did not choose me, no I chose you and I commissioned you to go out and bear fruit, fruit that will last.' (John 15:16)

This Sunday throughout the Church in Australia we celebrate National Vocations Awareness Week. This week we affirm and pray for all the baptised who are uniquely called by God. We acknowledge the Single Life, Married Life and Family Life, as well as all Lay Ministries within the Church. Please note that next weekend there will be a third collection for the support of the training of Dominican Vocations.

Pope Francis writes: "This is now the sixtieth time that we are celebrating the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, established by Saint Paul VI in 1964, during the Second Vatican Ecumenical Council. This providential initiative seeks to assist the members of the People of God, as individuals and as communities, to respond to the call and mission that the Lord entrusts to each of us in today's world, amid its afflictions and its hopes, its challenges and its achievements.

This Day is a precious opportunity for recalling with wonder that the Lord's call is grace, complete gift, and at the same time a commitment to bring the Gospel to others. We are called to a faith that bears witness, one that closely connects the life of grace, as experienced in the sacraments and ecclesial communion, to our apostolate in the world. Led by the Spirit, Christians are challenged to respond to existential peripheries and human dramas, ever conscious that the mission is God's work; it is not carried out by us alone, [it] has always been God's dream: that we should live with him in a communion of love."

I call all those who have been called to be Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion in our parish to a formation 'refresher'. The sessions to choose from are on Saturday 19 August at 2 pm, and Thursday 24 August at 6 pm. The session will be about an hour, plus time for questions. The material is provided by the Archdiocese, and presented by your parish staff and other parishioners.

Following this formation, you will be Nominated by the parish to the Archbishop, who will Mandate you as EMHCs for a certain period of time. Finally you will be commissioned for service in our parish at a Sunday Mass. We have been lax about following this process; now the Archbishop is calling us to renewal.

Your WWCC will have to be current, and you will have to complete a Child-Safe following your Commissioning, if you have not completed one already.

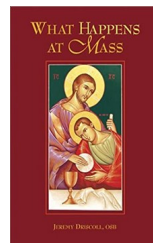

THE RESPONSORIAL PSALM

Silence is the initial response to the word we have heard...the silence of awe and adoration in the presence of God who has spoken to us...in which we can be reflective about the particular passage we have heard. .. If [Jesus Christ] is the Word spoken by God the Father to the Church, he will now also be the Word made flesh in the heart of this community, uttering a response to the Father. Without him our response would be .. pitiable. With him, it is completely adequate! The Father awaits our response to Jesus Christ whom he has spoken to us, but we choose Jesus himself as our response. .. We use the words of the psalms for our response. (pp. 41-42)

The Transfiguration

In today's Bible lesson, something happened that is called "transfiguration." Transfiguration means a complete change of appearance to be more beautiful. The Bible tells us that one day Jesus took three of His disciples, Peter, James, and John, and went up on a mountain to pray. As Jesus prayed, His face was changed and His clothes became a dazzling white. Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared and began talking to Jesus. Peter and the others had fallen asleep and when they woke up, they saw Jesus and the other two talking. They were amazed at that wonderful sight!

What an experience! Do you know what caused the face of Jesus to be changed and His clothes to become dazzling white? It was because they were in the presence of God! The Apostle Paul said in a letter he wrote to the church at Corinth, "For God, who said, 'Let there be light in the darkness,' has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ."

You and I have many wonderful experiences in our daily walk with Jesus. Others can see that we have the love of Jesus in our heart by seeing his reflection shining bright in us!

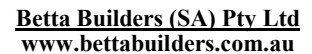
