## NATIONAL VOCATIONS AWARENESS WEEK – 2



Last Sunday focused on lay ministry; this Sunday on the ministry of ordained ministers (Deacons, Priests, Bishops).

The lay men and women who give Holy Communion are called 'Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion'. This name distinguishes them from the ordained minister who is the 'ordinary' minister, and minister of the Eucharist – 'ordinary' meaning that ordained ministry is essential for the way by which Jesus provides for his church the memorial of his death and resurrection. Therefore, there is always a need for the ministry of priests so that the

Church may be fed by the Eucharist. We believe that God calls some men to be priests. This week the Church prays that those whom God calls will respond generously. The Church also call on all of you to look out for potential priests and encourage them to consider this vocation.

The memorial of Jesus is kept in the celebration of the Mass, or Eucharist. So, the priest is the minister of the Eucharist. The fruit of the Eucharist is Holy Communion, the taking of the bread which is the sacrament of the Body of Christ. The priest takes Holy Communion himself and then gives it to others. The bread of the Eucharist that he has consecrated to be the Body of Christ can be given, as Holy Communion, to others by lay ministers. Hence there are 'ordinary' ministers, and 'extraordinary' ministers. Ordinary ministers are those who celebrate the Eucharist and give Holy Communion. Extraordinary ministers do not celebrate Mass but may give Holy Communion.

This 'extraordinary' ministry is called upon when necessary for the good of Christ's faithful. It is the bishop who appoints these ministers, with the co-operation of local priests. It is a sacred ministry. It is not a mere function. The minister of Holy Communion holds the salvation of the world in his or her hands and gives it to others. There is nothing insignificant about it. It calls for reverence, preparation and thanksgiving.

These are among the points of the 'refresher' formation sessions to be held on **Saturday 19 August at 2 pm** and on **Monday 21 August at 7 pm**. They will be held in Rosary church. **NOTE THE CORRECTION TO THE DATE AND TIME OF THE WEEKDAY EVENING SESSION.** (My mistake last week)

I must emphasise that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion – including those who take Holy Communion to sick people at home – **are required** to attend one or other of these sessions, if you wish to continue in this ministry. This is because I am to nominate you to the Archbishop as suitable for this ministry because you have been prepared for it in a way that accords with the sacred dignity of the sacrament that you are to serve to your fellow parishioners.

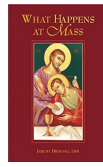
