A Full Day's Wages

Today in the Gospel, Jesus tells a story about several men who were hired to work at a vineyard. The Vineyard Owner hires workers at various times during the day, and then generously pays them ALL a full day's wages at the end of the day. This seems "unfair" to those who have worked hard all day in the hot sun.

Jesus tells us that the Kingdom of Heaven is like this too; some people spend their whole lives working for God, and some people only turn to Him at the last minute. But He is as generous to those who came last . This story teaches us about the generosity of God in salvation. God opens Heaven to all the people who choose to love Him. Everyone who believes in God and accepts His call receives the same reward (salvation) in the end.
