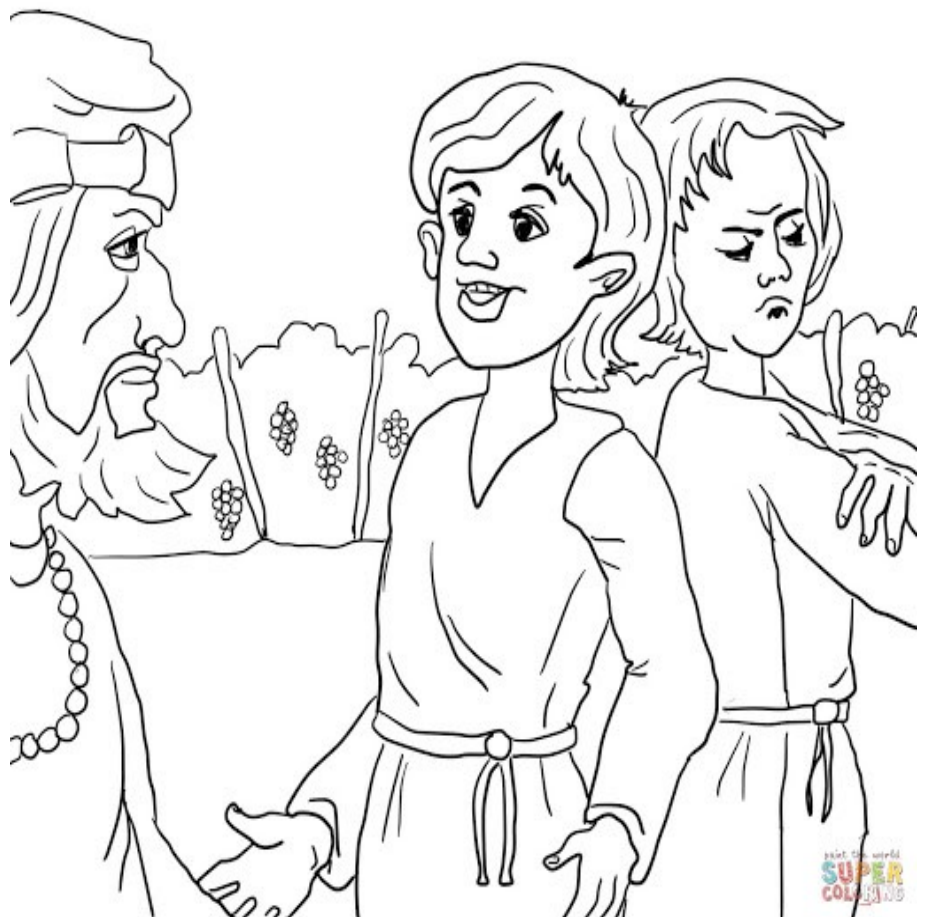
of this particular community here and now. Christ comes and is received as an actual communication of salvation to the particular assembly that here and now hears this word. (pp. 49-50)

Two Sons in the Vineyard

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells a story to show how different people obey what God has called them to do. In this parable there are two sons whose father asked them to help in the vineyard. The first son told his father he wouldn't help, but then changed his mind and did what he was asked. The second son said he would help, but he didn't. In the end it doesn't matter so much if we say we are going to do what's right. What is important is that we do it. We call ourselves Christians because we believe in Jesus and the Church He gave us, but we only really are being Christians if we do what He says. He wants us to realize that what we do is more important than what we say we will do.
