- (i) the two meetings were of a different nature: the Second Vatican Council was a general ('ecumenical') council with all the bishops of the world; the Synod on Synodality is an assembly of selected bishops and lay people and it's not finished yet!
- (ii) the development of technology (at Vatican II there was television but only wired, desk-top phones! No computers!!!)
- (iii) the world's understanding of whose voice matters and how to hear them has arrived in the Catholic church.


### **MARRIAGE MATTERS**

There is nothing wrong with working hard to be good at something and we all like to be recognized when we do something well. But showing off and acting like you're better than everyone else is never a good thing.


In our Bible lesson today, Jesus was talking about the Pharisees. They were a religious group in Jesus' day who tried to obey all of God's laws. Often, they acted like they were better than everyone else.

"Don't be like the Pharisees," Jesus warned.
"Everything they do is done for other people to see. They love to sit in the place of honour at banquets and in the most important seats in the synagogue; they love to be called 'teacher' by others."

What did Jesus say then about how we should act? Listen to what he said. "The greatest among you will be your servant. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."

If we expect others to look up to us, we must never look down on them.

Father, help us to avoid the temptation of being a show off, but rather help us to be humble in your sight. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
