PRAYER FOR PEACE AT ST LAURENCE'S

Every Friday at 7pm there will be an hour of silent adoration of the Blessed Sacrament exposed, at St Laurence's church, North Adelaide. The intention is to ask for peace, especially in the Holy Land and Ukraine. St Laurence's church is on the corner of Hill St and Buxton St, North Adelaide. Come when you can, even if only for a few minutes. Confession will be available from 7.30.



18/19 November – Vinnies Christmas Appeal.

Vinnies members will speak at all Eucharists this weekend, and distribute envelopes. The envelopes can be returned in a special collection next weekend. At that time the Christmas Giving Tree will be put in place. You can put your gifts of Christmas food and toys under the Giving Trees from next week.

9 December, 7 pm – Parish shared dinner. This will be held in Rosary church hall, as last year. Bring your favourite dish to share, especially something special to your culture. Come prepared to enjoy the company of fellow parishioners in a festive environment. The parish raffle will be drawn during the dinner.



14 December, 7 pm, Rosary Church – Confessions according to the Second Rite of Reconciliation.

This is a liturgy for the whole parish. It consists of prayers, readings from the Bible, a form of Examination of Conscience, a communal prayer of sorrow, and individual confessions. This form of Reconciliation is designed to express more clearly that our reconciliation with God involves also our reconciliation with each other; as we pray in every Eucharist, 'forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us'. Even if you do not make an individual confession that night, the liturgy is designed to arouse awareness of sin and contrition - the conditions for forgiveness

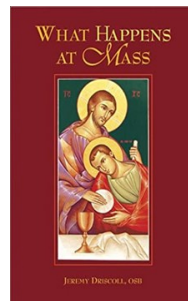
Bequests

THE HOMILY

A great tradition supports the preacher in (his) delicate task. .. apostolic faith. What the apostles experienced and believed has been handed on, 'traditioned' on through the centuries. Jesus entrusted his mission to his apostles, and it has been handed on through their successors, reaching as far as us. This fact, this shape of God's plan, is represented in the preaching of the bishop and those he has ordained. The commission to preach, which the apostles received from the Lord, parallels the Lord's own receiving of his mission from the Father. (p. 53) Even so, there is a difference in kind between the preaching of Jesus and the preaching of the apostles. Jesus, although bearing testimony to the Father, also bears testimony to himself (Lk 4:21 etc.) The apostles for their part bear testimony not to themselves but to Jesus. (p.53)

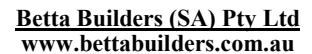
