


MARRIAGE MATTERS

THE HOMILY '.. the risen Lord said to his disciples, "As the Father sent me, so I send you" (John 20:21). In that same way, from those same mysterious depths, the apostolic preacher comes forth from the risen Lord.


Use Your Talents!
