## What is the Incarnation?

### Some questions and answers.

*This is another extract from the article "What is the Incarnation?", by Fr Thomas Casanova CCS, in "Contact", published by the Confraternity of Christ the Priest.*



The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary, and she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Incarnation means becoming man, from the Latin for 'in flesh'. Here, flesh stands for the whole of human nature, body and soul.

The incarnation refers to Jesus Whom we adore as true God and true Man. He always was and is God, with the Father and the Holy Spirit; but to become our Saviour He became one of us, in Israel, about 2023 years ago.

Let's look at some questions about this to understand it more deeply.

1. Where does the Catholic Church teach our belief in the Incarnation?

We proclaim this truth at Mass when we say the Nicene Creed, one of the early official summaries of the Faith of the Church. We declare,

*I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.*

We celebrate the Incarnation each Christmas and at the Solemnity of the Annunciation (25 March). Many Catholics around the world pray the Angelus at midday, a prayer which expresses this teaching.

### Comments:

For unknown reasons, in Adelaide we do not declare the Nicene Creed but the Apostles Creed, which reads: 'I believe .. in Jesus Christ his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary ..'

The Angelus is prayed in both our churches before the midday daily Mass. Please join in.

### Change of Lifestyle

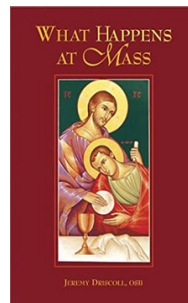

## THE PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL

The Church exists for the sake of the world and speaks a word of response to God in the name of the whole world...a movement of response to God's word on the part of the Church and for the sake of the world. It is this role of the Church that is articulated now in this prayer. The bishop inviting the faithful to articulate the prayer is the ritual expression – the mystery – of Christ entrusting to his body a responsibility in the world. By his own example Christ has taught us what and whom to care about. Now he waits for us to have a heart and mind like his. This is nothing less than his sharing with us his priestly role of interceding for the world. After we have expressed our needs, he himself will gather them together and make them his own, in the same way that the bishop will conclude the prayer: 'through Christ our Lord'. (p.59)
