What is the Incarnation? Some questions and answers.

2. How important is the Catholic teaching of the Incarnation?

The Incarnation is one of the most foundational and central beliefs of Christianity. Along with the Resurrection, it is at the heart of the Good News and of all our teachings. Sacraments and saints. Without the Incarnation there would be no reason why Our Blessed Lord's words would have more significance than the words of Moses or any other of the prophets and His saving death on the Cross would not have been the same extraordinary act of God's lowering Himself for us.

The Incarnation explains why the whole world rightly counts time from Him, including those who refer to the Christian era as the Common Era.

Like our belief in the Most Blessed Trinity (that there is one God in three Persons), the Incarnation is what we call a Mystery of Faith, something God has made known to us, and about which we can gain some understanding, but which is too deep for us ever fully to understand. In these mysteries, God reveals (teaches

us about) Himself and what He has done to save us. It is a gift of truth that brings us closer to God and helps us to be holy.

3. Which part of the Bible especially refers to the Incarnation?

The clearest verses about the Incarnation are in the first Chapter of the Gospel of St John:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. All things came to be through Him, and without Him nothing came to be. ... The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world ... and the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth.

No one has ever seen God. The only Son, God, who is at the Father's side, has revealed him. (cf. Jn 1:1-18)

The faith of the Church in the Incarnation is expressed admirably by the Apostle Thomas, who, upon seeing Jesus risen from the dead, with the holes visible in His hands and feet and side, declared "My Lord and my God!" (Jn 20:28)

Evangelisation Through our Sacrament

St Paul infers a deeper spirituality is found among the unmarried, yet writing to the Ephesians (5:32), he speaks of 'the profound mystery' of marriage and compares it to the relationship between Christ and the Church. The Lord is at the heart of our love for one another, providing the grace for daily living and evangelisation, through our Sacrament.



And so all that we are privileged to pray and say there, all that we receive there, we shall do in their name. (pp 59-60)

Baby Jesus is Presented in the Temple

On February 2, we celebrate the feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. That is the day that St Joseph and Our Lady took the baby Jesus to the Temple in

Jerusalem to consecrate Him to God. The Jews were supposed to dedicate their first-born sons to God, so Mary and Joseph were obedient to the law even though their Baby was God Himself!

This was a most amazing moment, even though almost nobody noticed it: here was the great Temple where the people came to worship God, and now God had actually come into it- as a little Baby! But only Mary and Joseph and the prophets Simeon and Anna knew what had happened.

St Paul tells us that our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit. Every time you receive Holy communion, it's like baby Jesus entering the Temple. When you go to Communion, remember that you have just received Jesus! What a special moment!
