What is the Incarnation?

Some questions and answers.

5. (Contd.) When did the Incarnation begin?

It happened on the day of the Annunciation which we celebrate on 25 March each year, when, as we say in the Angelus, '*The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary, and she conceived of the Holy Spirit.*'

In that moment, God the Son Who has no beginning, eternal with God the Father and God the Holy Spirit, took to himself a human body and soul...



Jesus is forever Emmanuel, God with us.

While the Incarnation began in time, it will never end. In the Bible, Jesus is called the 'eternal high priest'; He is seated at the right hand of the Father, with His risen and glorified human body, 'ever living to intercede for us.' (Hb 7:25) Forever Jesus is Emmanuel, God with us, blessing our human race with this greatest dignity.'

6. How are the human and divine natures joined in Jesus?

In theology we call this unique joining the **Hypostatic Union**. The two natures of Jesus are joined in **His one Divine Person**, the second person of the Blessed Trinity. A way to understand the difference between person and nature is this: **person** answers the question '**WHO are you?**', **WHO is responsible?**; and **nature** answers the question '**WHAT are you?**', what kind of thing are you, with what characteristics, abilities and powers.

Who is Jesus? He is God the Son, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity.

What is he? He is and always was God, but He is now also man.

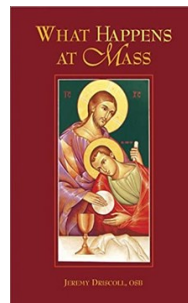
MARRIAGE MATTERS

Collecting the gifts.

In the same way that an intricate story of grace stands behind the arrival of each member of the assembly into the one place where the Eucharist will be offered, so many stories - whole lives - are being collected now and represented in bread and wine.

We also bring forward money, and we should not think of the collection of money at this point as some sort of banal, dirty but necessary affair. Money is our work. Money is hours of our lives. And now we give it away, we sacrifice it, for the work of the Church, which in the end is its work of charity and evangelisation. In the oldest description we have of the Mass from the second century, Saint Justin already speaks of the collection of money at this point in the liturgy. Jesus Heals

In today's Gospel, we're learning about when Jesus healed a leper. Don't confuse words here. Jesus didn't heal a leopard. He healed a leper. A leper was a person who was suffering from a terrible skin disease. It made big sores all over the body that were probably itchy and they were definitely not nice to look at. So, if a person had leprosy, they weren't allowed in the town. They had to live off on their own because other people didn't want to get the disease. Imagine how awful that would've been. You get a terrible disease, and instead of people taking care of you, everyone just ignores you. Well, Jesus didn't respond that way. In fact, one day when Jesus was teaching, a leper approached him. The leper knew that Jesus could heal him so he took a chance by asking him for help. Now, the people with Jesus were probably running away from this man but not Jesus. He looked right at the leper and said, "I'll heal you." And the man was healed instantly! See how compassionate Jesus is? This story teaches us an important lesson. Jesus cares about everyone, even the people who feel left out or unimportant. Let's remember that in our own lives and be kind to everyone, no matter who they are.
