# THE OBSERVANCES OF LENT

Prayer, fasting, almsgiving; or prayer, self-denial and helping others.

These observances are not just for Lent, but for every day and every season of the year.

Let's start with **Almsgiving**, **helping others**: The parish could benefit from your almsgiving – volunteering your time and talent. What about volunteering your services in the parish? You will find a chart in the porch of the church – or attached to your email – with a range of parish services which need your contribution of time and talent. Look for something that you can do, write your name and a point of contact on a piece of paper and put it in the collection box. Or else send an email to <a href="mailto:office@napparish.org.au">office@napparish.org.au</a> with your chosen service.



(At the same time, do not forget worthy charities, including Project Compassion.)

**Fasting, self-denial**: (eating less food). The regulations of the Church call on those between 18 and 60 years of age to practice fasting in Lent. How, is up to you. Abstinence from flesh meat applies on Ash Wednesday (too late now, sorry!) and Good Friday for all those over 14 years. It should not be noticed by anyone else. Deny yourself some pleasure that you will miss, but without doing yourself harm. (Matt 6:16-18)



**Prayer:** Remember, many words do not make much prayer. Jesus advice on prayer is given in Matthew 6:5-15.

If you do not have a habit of daily prayer, do it now. Plan a time of day, and place, that you know you can keep each day. Make sure

that you will not be disturbed (yes, turn the phone off – this could count as self-denial, too!).

Give yourself a point of focus – a lighted candle, silence, an icon, a crucifix .. let your attention dwell on Jesus, in one of the mysteries of his life, death or resurrection. The Lenten reflection book has Bible references for each day, or your Sunday Missal has the Mass readings for the Sundays of Lent.

Be aware of his presence with you. You don't always have to say anything; you may allow Jesus to speak to you in the silence. (Don't expect to hear voices, but you will know what he wants to say.)



We can come closer to Jesus in these three ways: Jesus 'went about doing good' (Acts 10:38), 'had nowhere to lay his head' (Matt 8:20; Luke 9:58), and himself taught us to pray (Matt 6:9-13)


# **MARRIAGE MATTERS**

Collecting the gifts. One of the principal words with which the tradition has understood the Mass is to speak of it as a sacrifice... There is a precise Christian understanding to the term... St Paul helps us to understand this specific Christian sense. For him the death and resurrection of Christ and our communion in these have introduced an entirely new reality into the world,

beginning from Christ's submission to the Jewish Law, but extending outward from there to include all Gentiles with a share in the promise. As a result, the Old Law and its sacrifices no longer have validity. There is a new covenant and a new kind of sacrifice... The new sacrifice of Christians, as opposed to the animal sacrifices offered in the Temple, is the very body of the Christian offered to God in a holy life. (cf. Rom 12:1) This is called 'spiritual worship' ... Our bodies as a living sacrifice – this is what the collection of gifts is meant to enact... They can only do it through, with, and in Christ's offering. This is what is enacted in what follows. (pp. 61-2)

In today's Gospel, we learn that Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness. The Bible tells us He was surrounded by wild animals but angels took care of him. He was led there by the Spirit so that He could be alone with God to think about his work and pray over his future plans. Through fasting and prayer, he prepared himself to travel the hard road that lay ahead. This was a time that Jesus had to endure before he could call his followers and begin his earthly ministry by calling his disciples to come and follow him.

Today is the first Sunday in the season of Lent- the time leading up the celebration of Easter. It is a time when we pray and think about all that Jesus has done for us. Some people observe lent by giving up something that they like very much such as

eating candy, playing video games, watching TV, or going to the movies. Others observe Lent by trying to concentrate on doing good for other people such as giving to the poor or visiting the sick. Most of all, Lent is a time when we focus on the call of Jesus when he said, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." (Luke 9:23) Just as Jesus spent forty days in the wilderness in preparation for his ministry. Lent is a good time for us to draw closer to God and dedicate ourselves to following Jesus. Heavenly Father, just as Jesus spent forty days in the wilderness to prepare for doing your work on earth, help us to use this special time of the year to prepare our hearts for serving you in our world. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.


# Day of the Unborn Child Appeal
