# The Purpose of the Human Person

In his Summa Theologiae St Thomas Aquinas spends sometime meditating on the purpose of human existence. He asks for what ultimate end was the human person made? Aquinas' answer falls upon one word "happiness". The Angelic Doctor then discerns what kind of things can bring happiness; can wealth bring perfect happiness? Can honour, fame or glory? Can power? Can any bodily good? Can pleasure? Can any spiritual good?

All of these things however do not pass St Thomas' test because all these so called goods, which one may seek so as to acquire happiness, are created, material goods. These types of goods are limited, transitory, capable of corruption, or are concluded in their usufruct by the death of the one that experiences them. St Thomas is a lot more optimistic than we are though! Most of us would probably settle for a few more dollars in the bank, or a bit of fame or power, or maybe non stop pleasure. Not Thomas. He will only settle for perfect, interminable happiness which can only be found in the supreme good which is God.

God's goodness then is not something that is added to God accidentally, it is not a quality like one might talk of a good apple or a good cricket bat. Goodness is not essential to apples or cricket bats, because there are some real crumby ones. For God to be called good we mean that it is essential for God to be good. If we speak of goodness we must have some standard by which to judge, and God is just that, the perfect good by which all good things are measured.

Realising then that God is what it means to be total, perfect goodness, the human heart inclines towards this good even if it doesn't immediately recognise it. The human will tends to the perfect good because that is what fulfils it ultimately. A materialistic pursuit will never cut it.

This is where our feast comes into the equation. Jesus' ascension points out the purpose of human existence, namely, to embrace perfect happiness in the life of God. Jesus ascends not to go on some heavenly journey through the clouds to some outer space location, rather the ascension into heaven means the elevating of the human person into a dimension which transcends this existence. The clouds and upward facing movement of the Lord are metaphoric for this translation of our human nature to the locus of the divine.

Of import for us is that Jesus ascends in his earthly but resurrected human body, the mysterious body which could pass through closed doors, or disappear from sight in the blink of an eye, yet, the same body which had flesh that could be touched and bones that could be handled, the same body that could eat a piece of fish, the same body which still displayed the wounds of the passion, all very human yet also paradoxically unearthly.

It is with this body that the risen Lord enters into the new existence of the Father. Yet, in keeping this human body Jesus symbolically brings all humanity to the source of its purpose. Jesus' true humanity in the flesh even now interfaces with the divine representing for us the destiny for which we were made. Indeed the Lord Jesus blazes a trail for us in this feast signposting that our desires will be met, our yearning will cease, our joy will be unalloyed and it will only be found in God.
